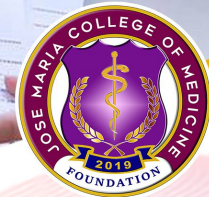

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

FRESHMAN

The basic requirements for acceptance into the medical school are:

1. A graduate of any four-year baccalaureate degree
2. Has taken the National Medical Admission Test (NMAT) within the last two (2) years and with at least a percentile score of 40
3. Interested applicants must submit original or certified true copies of the following:
 - 3.1. Accomplished Application Form (downloadable at www.medicine.jmc.edu.ph)
 - 3.2. NMAT Result
 - 3.3. Certificate of General Weighted Average (GWA)
 - 3.4. Transcript of Record
 - 3.5. Certificate of Good Moral Character from previous school
 - 3.6. Recommendation Letter from previous Dean, Professors or any school authority
 - 3.7. Two (2) pieces of 2 x 2 photo

TRANSFEE

1. A transferee is a student who is currently or was previously enrolled in another medical school.
2. He or she must submit the following:
 - 2.1. Accomplished Application Form (downloadable at www.medicine.jmc.edu.ph)
 - 2.2. NMAT Result of at least 40 Percentile Score
 - 2.3. Certificate of General Weighted Average during college
 - 2.4. Transcript of Records during college
 - 2.5. Certificate of Good Moral Character from previous school
 - 2.6. Recommendation Letter from previous Dean, Professors or any school authority
 - 2.7. Two (2) pieces of 2 x 2 photo
 - 2.8. Documents from the last medical school attended:
 - Certificate of Eligibility for Admission to Medical School
 - Transcript of Record
 - Certificate of Transfer Credential & Honorable Dismissal
