#### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

#### **FRESHMAN**

The basic requirements for acceptance into the medical school are:

- 1. A graduate of any four-year baccalaureate degree
- 2. Has taken the National Medical Admission Test (NMAT) within the last two (2) years and with at least a percentile score of 40
- 3. Interested applicants must submit original or certified true copies of the following:
  - 3.1. Accomplished Application Form (downloadable at www.medicine.jmc.edu.ph)
  - 3.2. NMAT Result
  - 3.3. Certificate of General Weighted Average (GWA)
  - 3.4. Transcript of Record
  - 3.5. Certificate of Good Moral Character from previous
  - 3.6. Recommendation Letter from previous Dean, Professors or any school authority
  - 3.7. Two (2) pieces of 2 x 2 photo

#### **TRANSFEREE**

- 1. A transferee is a student who is currently or was previously enrolled in another medical school.
- 2. He or she must submit the following:
  - 2.1. Accomplished Application Form (downloadable at www.medicine.jmc.edu.ph)
  - 2.2. NMAT Result of at least 40 Percentile Score
  - 2.3. Certificate of General Weighted Average during college
  - 2.4. Transcript of Records during college
